(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC
AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER
2009
NOTICE OF MAKING

1. The Council of the London Borough of Ealing being the traffic authority for Albert Road, Castlebar Park and Harrow View Road HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate the construction of entry treatments at the junctions of these roads with Pitshanger Lane, it has made an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding into or exiting from Albert Road, Castlebar Park and Harrow View Road at their junctions with Pitshanger Lane.
2. No person shall, until the said works have been completed, cause any vehicle to enter or exit Albert Road, Castlebar Park and Harrow View Road at their junctions with Pitshanger Lane.
3. No person shall, until the said works have been completed, cause any vehicle to wait or park in any length of Albert Road, Castlebar Park and Harrow View Road within the first 20 metres adjacent to their junctions with Pitshanger Lane which has traffic cones indicating that such waiting or parking is prohibited.
4. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and the above closures will be phased as the works progress.
5. Whilst the temporary restrictions (operative at any time) remain in force displaced vehicular traffic should follow advance warning and diversion signs displayed and any other traffic management in place wherever necessary on site to reach their desired destination.
6. Nothing in the proposed Order shall apply to anything done:
 - a) with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - b) to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - c) to any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works.
7. The Order, which would have a maximum duration of 18 months, will come into operation on 2nd November 2009. The road closures and other measures for the works are expected to be in force until 26th November 2009. The works will be phased with only one road being closed at any one time.
